## RESOLUTION 2019-R-98

### AUTHORIZE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Maple Shade Board of Education and the Township of Maple Shade previously determined to provide for one Maple Shade Police Department Officer to be assigned to the School District on a full-time basis as a School Resource Officer (“SRO”); and

**WHEREAS**, as provided in the Shared Service Agreement for these services, the parties annually evaluate whether the program should be continued and have determined that is in the best interest of the School District and the Township to continue this program.

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:65-4. et seq. provides that local units may enter into an agreement to provide or to receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the School Resource Officer Shared Services Agreement shall be effective for the 2019-2020 School Year, commencing on September 1, 2019 and terminating on June 30, 2020, at an estimated cost to the Board of Education of \$89,474 (one-half of the pensionable salary of the School Resource Officer).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1) That the Township Council hereby agrees to enter into an agreement with the Maple Shade Board of Education for the assignment of one Township police officer to the School District as the School Resource Officer for the 2019-2020 school year, subject to the sharing of costs and such other terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement and further subject to the Board of Education approving the Agreement.

2) That the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Shared Service Agreement on behalf of the Township in a form approved by the Township Attorney.

## **RESOLUTION 2019-R-99**

### **AUTHORIZE SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN MAPLE SHADE TOWNSHIP AND MAPLE SHADE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR CLASS III OFFICER SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Maple Shade Board of Education seeks to provide additional security in the Township Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has instituted the use of Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board and Township agree that a Shared Services Agreement, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. providing for the use of Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers for school security promotes their mutual public purposes and best interests; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:65-4. et seq. provides that local units may enter into an agreement to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Class III Officer Shared Services Agreement shall be effective for the 2019-2020 School Year, commencing on September 1, 2019 and terminating on June 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police shall assign four (4) Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers (the "Officers") who will serve as security for the Township Public Schools; and

**WHEREAS** the Board shall be responsible for the costs of the Officers' training, uniforms and for their vehicle modifications in addition to the Officers' salary; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1) That the Township Council hereby agrees to enter into an agreement with the Maple Shade Board of Education for the assignment of four Class III Officer to the Township School District for the 2019-2020 school year, subject to the payment of salaries and related costs and

such other terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement and further subject to the Board of Education approving the Agreement.

2) That the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Shared Service Agreement on behalf of the Township in a form approved by the Township Attorney.

AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT WITH BURLINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS FOR ACQUISITION OF EASEMENTS FOR BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the County of Burlington is undertaking the rehabilitation of its Bridge No. B4.61 located on Main Street in Maple Shade: and

**WHEREAS**, the project requires the acquisition of certain easements on the Maple Shade Township Water Plant Property, identified as Block 82.01, Lots 10 and 11 on the Official Tax Map of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders has offered compensation in the amount of \$11,150.00 for the acquisition of 3500 sq. feet of easement area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Utility staff has determined that the proposed easements will not interfere with the operation or security of the Main Street Water Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, grant of the easements shall allow for the improvement and future maintenance of the bridge.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1. That the Township hereby agrees to provide the easements requested by the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders for compensation in the amount of \$11,150.00;
2. That the Township Council shall adopt an ordinance authorizing the grant of the easements to the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders;
3. That the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the letter of acceptance and to execute the easements and all closing documents required for the sale of the property interests.
