**WHEREAS** the Board shall be responsible for the costs of the Officers' training, uniforms and for their vehicle modifications in addition to the Officers' salary; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1) That the Township Council hereby agrees to enter into an agreement with the Maple Shade Board of Education for the assignment of four Class III Officer to the Township School District for the 2021-2022 school year, subject to the payment of salaries and related costs and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the governing body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to NJAC 5:30-6.5; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

Whereas, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S 52:27BB-52 – to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52- A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to abbey and order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his/her office."
