
5. 2022 NJ SENIOR OLYMPICS

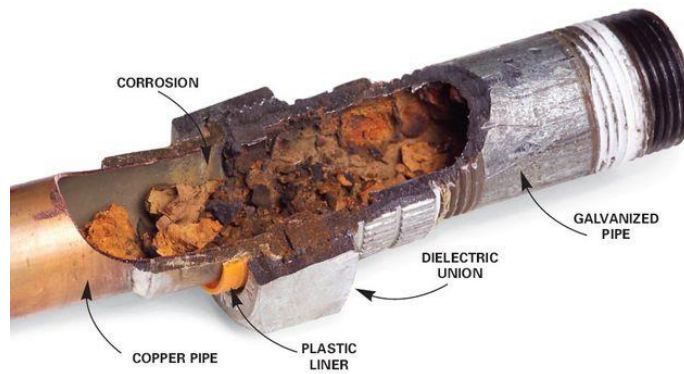

9. UTILITIES

LEAD SERVICE LINES



The identification of lead (and galvanized) service lines is the responsibility of the water system owner and is required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. Lead has been recognized as an element associated with serious health concerns. The only way to determine if you have an exposure to lead through the water system is to positively identify the material of construction of your service line. Initially, there were 477 properties in Maple Shade where the material of construction of the service line was unknown. In June 2022, the utility mailed out letters to those unknown properties. As a result of the response to those letters, we were able to decrease that number to 330 unknowns.

In August, we will again be sending letters to the 330 properties which are still unknown. If you receive one of these letters in August, please call the utility at the number in the letter (856-488-7450) and ask the operator for an appointment to “identify unknown service line”. This is a very quick inspection. The inspection is free of charge and takes less than five minutes.

This is the critical first step in removing lead from the water system and we appreciate your cooperation.
