4. TRASH COLLECTION

The Township recognizes the ongoing delays residents have been experiencing with trash collection over the past several weeks. Continued staffing shortages across the waste hauling industry along with mechanical issues and unusually heavy volume of waste being collected throughout town have played a significant role in the delays residents are continuing to see. Township Officials maintain contact on a regular basis with the hauler, and we are confident the staffing and mechanical issues are being addressed. Central Jersey Waste has assured us they are in the process of hiring additional staff and training of those employees is ongoing. As result the new employees are not as familiar with the Township collection route and therefore, we are seeing missed collection on a regular basis. We are hopeful over the next few weeks, as drivers and collectors become more familiar with our community, missed collection will be reduced greatly. During this time however, residents may continue to experience later than normal pick-up times of their solid waste.

If residents have not had their trash collected on their normally scheduled collection day with the exception of holidays, please leave your containers at the curb until the next day. In most instances, the hauler was simply delayed, and they will return the following day to collect the solid waste. Residents may call the Township at (856) 779-9610, ext. 113 or 221 to advise the Township of the missed collection and so that we may ensure the hauler is aware of the issue.

Lastly, residents are asked to be mindful when placing items at the curb for collection. Below are some helpful reminders when placing waste at the curb:

- Containers and waste should continue to be placed at curb no later than 6am on your regularly scheduled collection day;
- Large items should be broken down; if they cannot fit in a container they should be placed neatly along the curb-line so they may be easily collected;
- Mattresses and box-springs must be wrapped in plastic for sanitary and safety of the collectors;
- Brush/twigs/branches may not be disposed of in the regular trash – these items are collected by the Department of Public Works;
- No more than seven (7) items may be placed at the curb for collection – Entire home / garage/basement/attic cleanouts may not be placed at the curb for collection.

Taking the above measures will help the hauler collect waste more efficiently, but it will also help to keep costs down for the municipality.
