Plastic Bottles and Food Containers



Empty and rinse containers.
No loose caps.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay!
No caps or lids.



Metal CANS Only

Remove labels on aluminum cans.
Don't crush!

SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM

Metal bar must face the street.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO shredded paper



NO Styrofoam



NO plastic with a



NO plastic bags, wrap, plastic envelopes, or shipping packaging



NO plant pots, straws, trays, lids, cups, or loose caps



NO hoses or hangers



NO hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes



NO foil items, bulbs, cookware, or window glass



NO motor oil, batteries, or hazardous items



NEVER put syringes in recycling!

CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

- We find hazardous items, like needles and batteries in boxes that residents set out for recycling.
FOR THIS REASON, YOU MUST EMPTY AND FLATTEN YOUR BOXES.
- Never use boxes to hold ANY recyclables.

You can recycle rechargeable batteries at Home Depot, Lowes, and other big box stores.
