AWARD OF CONTRACT TO BOOTH MECHANICAL, INC. FOR INSTALLATION OF A WATER MAIN ON LIPPINCOTT AND TERRACE AVENUE FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$37,875.00

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined to provide for the replacement of the water main on Lippincott and Terrace Avenues, particularly described in quotes attached with this resolution, and it appearing that the cost of the aforementioned installation will be paid with Municipal Funds not to exceed \$37,875.00 in the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Utilities Manager has satisfactorily obtained three (3) quotes for the purpose of awarding a contract for the aforementioned purpose and the Township Manager has informed the Township Council that a certain entity is the lowest, qualified responsible bidder for said contract and has recommended that the Township Council award said contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Chief Financial Officer, has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of awarding a contract to said entity, said certification being attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the Township Council, based upon the aforementioned certificate, hereby declares that there are sufficient funds available for the aforesaid purpose, and the Township Council hereby directs that the hereinafter expenditure be charged against Account #C-06-216-21-010-002

2. That the Township Council, for the aforementioned reasons, hereby declares that Booth Mechanical, Inc., 42 N. Lippincott Avenue, Maple Shade, NJ (08052) is the lowest qualified bidder for the aforementioned contract and hereby awards a contract to the said entity for the aforesaid purpose for an amount not to exceed \$37,875.00 in accordance with the terms and conditions of Estimate #WC-2226, dated August 8th, 2022.
