WHEREAS, the Township Council, by previous Resolution, awarded a contract to Charles Marandino, LLC for the FY 2019 and 2020 N.J.D.O.T. Municipal Aid Program/improvements to Collins Lane and North Coles Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Richard A. Alaimo Association of Engineers, the Township's agent responsible for supervising the FY 2019 and 2020 N.J.D.O.T. 
WHEREAS, the Township Council has reviewed the request and desires to act favorably with respect to same and to amend the contract accordingly and to approve the change order.




