- a. We are receiving complaints about the noise coming from the gun range due to the removal of the brush and are working with the organization
- b. There is a need to review the Site Plan fees to applicants
2. Police Report
 - a. 2023 had 2,913 calls for service, less than 2022. The partnerships that the PD established has helped
 - b. Hotel calls dropped by 50% thanks to having officer Shaw on board
 - c. 43 Narcan cases
 - d. The Chief is serving as second vice president for the Chiefs Association
 - e. The beards program has raised almost \$10,000
3. Site Plan
 - a. PSE&G bought the old Roy Rogers property and wants to expand towers within fifty feet of Route 73
 - b. W. Park -addition going to Zoning Board
 - c. 301 E. Main asking for addition apartment
 - d. 29 Willow Road, Flanagans wants to expand
 - e. 2910 Route 73, Fox Meadow, requesting the use of new mobile dumpsters
 - f. 105 W. Main Street - cancelled
4. Cannabis Ordinance – the township is looking to approve three retail, 1 cultivating, and 1 delivery license (5) total, basically on Routes 38 and 73. An ordinance is being created for council review

NEW BUSINESS

1. There have been increase complaints from businesses about parking on Main Street and extended parking in the Municipal lots behind Main Street. Discussions are ongoing to resolve the issues.
2. A Citizen Volunteer form has come in for the Planning Board. Council approved Daniel McDonald as an Alternate.
3. Baseball is requesting temporary lighting for tournaments (9-9:30pm) at Fellowship and Nolan Field #3, They say eight would work, but the council feels regulations must be in place to keep the peace in the neighborhood. Questions are: who pays for it and who notifies the neighbors?
4. There was a request for the Council to readdress a Chicken Ordinance. Yes, it will be discussed.
