



## **FIRE SAFETY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**

Dear Vendor:

You are required to comply with the following codes and obtain the proper permit if the following is applicable.

N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, 308.3 **Use of open flame:** The use of any open flame or flame producing device, in connection with any public gathering, for the purpose of entertainment, amusement, or recreation. A Type 1 permit is required at the sum of \$54.00. Check made payable to the Township of Maple Shade.

N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, 3004.1 **Storage position:** Compressed gas container, cylinders, and tanks, except those designed for the used in a horizontal position, and all compressed gas container, cylinders and tanks containing non-liquefied gases, shall be stored with the valve end up.

N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, 3003.5.3 **Securing of cylinders:** Compressed gas container, cylinders and tanks shall be secured to prevent falling caused by contact, vibration, or seismic activity.

N.J.A.C. 570-3, 308.3.1.1 **Liquefied petroleum gas fueled cooking devices:** Portable LP-Gas cooking equipment such as barbecue grills and outdoor fireplaces shall not be stored or used:

1. On any porch, balcony, or any other portion of a building
2. Within any room or space in a building
3. Within 5 feet (1524mm) of any combustible exterior wall
4. Within 5 feet (1524mm), vertically or horizontally, of an opening in any wall
5. Under any building or overhang

Once application for the permit is made, the day of the event, a fire inspector will come to your display to inspect and ensure that you are in compliance with these regulations.

A permit must be obtained at least on week prior to the day of the operation at the Maple Shade Fire Marshal's Office, 200 Stiles Avenue, Maple Shade, NJ 08052, 856.779.9610 ext. 179.
