RESOLUTION APPROVING APPOINTMENT OF AN INTERIM UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, there exists a temporary vacancy in the position of Uniform Construction Code Inspector within the Township of Maple Shade; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:23 et seq., the Township is required to ensure that qualified personnel are available to carry out inspections and enforcement responsibilities under the Uniform Construction Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township Construction Official has recommended to the Township Manager that the interim appointment of Keith Raveling to serve as a UCC Inspector on an interim basis to ensure continuity of operations and compliance with the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Raveling holds the appropriate licenses and certifications issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) to perform inspections in the following disciplines: Building, Fire, Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical; and

WHEREAS, the interim appointment is made in accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.5 and other applicable laws governing temporary or interim UCC appointments; and

WHEREAS, this appointment is contingent upon availability of funds and shall not exceed a term of sixty (60) days unless further extended or permanently filled, subject to any applicable Civil Service and DCA requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:
