**WHEREAS**, the Maple Shade Board of Education seeks to provide additional security in the Township Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has instituted the use of Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board and Township agree that a Shared Services Agreement, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. providing the use of Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers for school security promotes their mutual public purposes and best interest; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:65-4 et seq. provides that local units may enter into an agreement to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Class III Officer Shared Service Agreement shall be effective for the 2025-2026 School Year, commencing September 1, 2025 and termination on June 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police shall assign four (4) Class III Special Law Enforcement Officer (“the Officers) who will serve as security for the Township Public School; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education shall be responsible for the costs of the Officers’ training, uniforms and for their vehicle modifications in addition to the Officers salary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1. The Township Council hereby agrees to enter into an agreement with the Maple Shade Board of Education for the assignment of four (4) Class III Officers to the Township School District for the 2025-2026 school year, subject to the payment of salaries and related costs and such other terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement as attached hereto; and
2. The Mayor and Township Manager are hereby authorized to execute the Shared Services Agreement on behalf of the Township in a form approved by the Township Solicitor.

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, DETERMINING THE FORM AND OTHER DETAILS OF ITS "BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION FINANCING PROGRAM OF THE NEW JERSEY INFRASTRUCTURE BANK", TO BE ISSUED IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$4,500,000, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SUCH NOTE TO THE NEW JERSEY INFRASTRUCTURE BANK, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF SUCH NOTE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE IN FAVOR OF THE NEW JERSEY INFRASTRUCTURE BANK, ALL PURSUANT TO THE NEW JERSEY INFRASTRUCTURE BANK CONSTRUCTION FINANCING PROGRAM**

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**BACKGROUND**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Maple Shade ("Township"), in the County of Burlington, New Jersey, has determined that there exists a need within the Township for the removal and replacement of existing lead service lines (collectively, the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Township to obtain financing for such Project through participation in the environmental infrastructure financing program ("Financing Program") of the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank ("I-Bank"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has determined to temporarily finance the construction of the Project (Project No. 0319001-001) prior to the closing with respect to the Financing Program, and to undertake such temporary financing with the proceeds of a short-term loan to be made by the I-Bank (the "Construction Loan") to the Township, pursuant to the Construction Financing Program of the I-Bank ("Construction Financing Program"); and

**WHEREAS**, in order to: (i) evidence and secure the repayment obligation of the Township to the I-Bank with respect to the Construction Loan; and (ii) satisfy the requirements of the Construction Financing Program, it is the desire of Township to issue and sell to the I-Bank the "Bond Anticipation Note Relating to the Construction Financing Program of the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank" in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$4,500,000 ("Note"); and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Township to authorize, execute, attest and deliver the Note to the I-Bank pursuant to the terms of the Local Bond Law of the State of New Jersey, constituting Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey ("Local Bond Law"), and other applicable law; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 28 of the Local Bond Law and Section 9 of the I-Bank Act permit the sale of the Note to the I-Bank, without any public offering, all pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth, respectively, therein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO LOCAL BUDGET LAW, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The obligation represented by the Note has been appropriated and authorized by bond ordinance 2023-16 of the Township, which bond ordinance: (i) is entitled, "BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$4,500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$4,500,000 BOND OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF" and was finally adopted by the Township at a meeting duly called and held on September 14, 2023, at which time a quorum was present and acted throughout; (ii) thereafter duly published as required; and (iii) is in full force and effect, all pursuant to and in satisfaction of the terms of the Local Bond Law and other applicable law.

**Section 2.** In accordance with Section 28 of the Local Bond Law and Section 9 of the I-Bank Act, the City hereby authorizes the issuance, sale and award of the Note to the I-Bank in accordance with the provisions hereof.

**Section 3.** The Chief Financial Officer of the Township ("Chief Financial Officer") is hereby authorized to determine, in accordance with the Local Bond Law, the I-Bank Act, other applicable law and pursuant to the terms and conditions hereof: (i) the final principal amount of the Note (subject to the maximum limitation set forth in Section 5(a) hereof); (ii) the dated date of the Note; and (iii) the interest rate of the Note.

**Section 4.** Any determination made by the Chief Financial Officer pursuant to the terms hereof shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution and attestation of the Note by the parties authorized pursuant to Section 5(h) hereof.

**Section 5.** The Township hereby determines that certain terms of the Note shall be as follows:

- (a) the principal amount of the Note to be issued shall be an amount up to \$4,500,000;
- (b) the maturity of the Note shall be as determined by the I-Bank;
- (c) the interest rate of the Note shall be as determined by the I-Bank;
- (d) the purchase price for the Note shall be par;
- (e) the Note shall be subject to prepayment prior to its stated maturity in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Note;
- (f) the Note shall be issued in a single denomination and shall be numbered "CFP-25-\_\_\_\_";
- (g) the Note shall be issued in fully registered form and shall be payable to the registered owner thereof as to both principal and interest in lawful money of the United States of America; and
- (h) the Note shall be executed by the manual or facsimile signatures of the Mayor and the Chief Financial Officer under official seal or facsimile thereof affixed, printed,

engraved or reproduced thereon and attested by the manual signature of the Township Clerk.

**Section 6.** The Note shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**Section 7.** The Mayor, Administrator, and Chief Financial Officer, Township Clerk, and Deputy Township Clerk (collectively, the "Authorized Officers") of the Township are hereby further severally authorized to: (i) execute and deliver, and the Township Clerk and Deputy Township Clerk are hereby further authorized to attest to such execution and to affix the corporate seal of the Township to, any document, instrument or closing certificate deemed necessary, desirable or convenient by the Authorized Officers or the Secretary of the Township, as applicable, in their respective sole discretion, after consultation with counsel and any advisors to the Township and after further consultation with the I-Bank and its representatives, agents, counsel and advisors, to be executed in connection with the issuance and sale of the Note and the participation of the Township in the Construction Financing Program, which determination shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of each such certificate or other document by the party authorized hereunder to execute such certificate or other document; and (ii) perform such other actions as the Authorized Officers deem necessary, desirable or convenient in relation to the execution and delivery of the Note and the participation of the Township in the Construction Financing Program.

**Section 8.** All actions heretofore taken and documents prepared or executed by or on behalf of the Township by the Mayor, Chief Financial Officer, Township Clerk, other Township officials or by the Township's professional advisors, in connection with the issuance and sale of the Notes are hereby ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.

**Section 9.** All other resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded and repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

**Section 10.** This resolution shall take effect immediately, this 16th day of October, 2025.
