**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024-14  
(WHICH PROVIDES FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS)  
HERETOFORE FINALLY ADOPTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, IN THE COUNTY OF  
BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2024, TO  
AMEND THE DESCRIPTION SET FORTH THEREIN**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
MAPLE SHADE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY** (not less than two-thirds  
of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), **AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The bond ordinance of the Township of Maple Shade, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), heretofore finally adopted by the Township Council on September 12, 2024, numbered 2024-14 and entitled, "BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS 2024 GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$3,140,000 THEREFOR (INCLUDING TWO GRANTS IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$445,680) AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,565,600 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF" (the "Original Ordinance"), which Original Ordinance is hereby amended such that Section 3(a) thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

**"SECTION 3. (a)** The improvements hereby authorized and purposes for the financing of which said bonds or notes are to be issued include, but are not limited to, as follows:

(ii) <b><u>Recreational Improvements</u></b> – Various Improvements To Recreational Facilities Including, But Not Limited To, Replacement Of Concession Stand Roof And Various Improvements To Recreational Facilities;	\$125,000	\$119,000	\$6,000	15.00 years

**SECTION 2.** The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended, as necessary, to conform with the provisions of this amendatory bond ordinance and to the extent of any inconsistency herewith, a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (the “Director of the Division of Local Government Services”), will be on file in the office of the Clerk and will be available for public inspection.

**SECTION 3.** Except as expressly amended hereby, the Original Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
