Resolution for Deferred School Taxes

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services requires that a resolution be adopted by a majority of the governing body prior to the introduction of the annual budget of the year subsequent to the deferral, authorizing an increase in the amount of the deferral, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Members of Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington to increase the amount of the local school deferred taxes by \$600,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Members of Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, that the amount of deferred local school taxes be increased to \$15,227,678.00 as of December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer advertised for bids and received and opened bids on March 12, 2026, for the Police Department Jail Cell Renovations Project and informed the Township Manager that a certain entity is the lowest, qualified responsible bidder for said contract and recommended that the Township Council award said contract or reject said bids within sixty (60) days as required by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Chief Financial Officer, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:30-1, has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of awarding a contract to said entity, said certification being attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey, as follows:
