**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.3 (b), has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of said purchase in an amount not to exceed \$403,767.64 and to be charged from account C-04-215-24-014-001 in which said certification is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

PROTECTION GREEN ACRES PROGRAM ENABLING RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program (“State”), provides grants and/or loans to municipal and county governments and grants to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the acquisition, development, and stewardship of lands for outdoor recreation and conservation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Maple Shade desires to further the public interest by obtaining total funding in the amount of \$899,000, in the form of a \$349,750 matching grant and, if available, a \$549,250 loan, from the State to fund the following project(s): Improvements to Woodlawn Sports Complex at a cost of \$1,399,000;

**WHEREAS**, the State shall determine if the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Green Acres Program, and notify the applicant of the amount of the funding award; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicant is willing to use the State’s funds in accordance with such rules, regulations, and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the State for the above-named project;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the governing body/board resolves that:

1. The Mayor and Township Clerk is hereby authorized to:
  - a. make application for such a loan and/or such a grant,
  - b. provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required, and
  - c. act as the authorized correspondent of the above-named applicant;
2. The applicant agrees to provide its matching share to the Green Acres funding request, if a match is required, in the amount of **\$1,049,250.00**;
3. In the event the State’s funds are less than the total project cost specified above, the applicant has the balance of funding necessary to complete the project;
4. The applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project; and
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
