RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE GRACE PERIOD FOR THE PAYMENT OF THIRD QUARTER 2026 PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, due to structural processing delays in the final certification of the regional property tax rate, the printing, processing, and mailing of the 2026 final property tax bills for the Township of Maple Shade were collectively delayed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to statutory New Jersey State law **N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.1**, third-quarter property taxes are standardly due and payable on August 1, 2026, with a standard ten (10) day statutory grace period expiring on August 10, 2026; and

WHEREAS, statutory provisions dictate that a minimum of twenty-five (25) calendar days must be legally provided to taxpayers for payment from the actual certified date that final tax bills are mailed out to property owners; and

WHEREAS, the final property tax bills were successfully processed and physically deposited into the United States Postal Service mail system on **August 17, 2026**; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade desires to formally establish a fair, extended grace period to protect local property owners from receiving unmerited delinquent interest penalties caused strictly by administrative tax processing delays;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Extended Grace Period:** The standard statutory grace period for the payment of third-quarter 2026 property taxes is hereby formally extended from August 10, 2026, to **September 18, 2026**.
- 1. Interest Accrual Rule:** Any third-quarter property tax payment received by the Maple Shade Tax Collector after the newly extended cutoff date noted above shall be certified as delinquent. Interest fees will retroactively accrue back to the original statutory due date of August 1, 2026, as required by state law.
- 2. Mailing Authorization:** The Tax Collector is authorized to note this extended grace period on the face of the issued bills or distribute clear secondary notifications directly to municipal property owners.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police shall assign four (4) Class III Special Law Enforcement Officer ("the Officers") who will serve as security for the Township Public School; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education shall be responsible for the costs of the Officers' training, uniforms and for their vehicle modifications in addition to the Officers salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington as follows:

1. The Township Council hereby agrees to enter into an agreement with the Maple Shade Board of Education for the assignment of four (4) Class III Officers to the Township School District for the 2026-2027 school year, subject to the payment of salaries and related costs and such other terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement as attached hereto; and

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLE SHADE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BURLINGTON COUNTY FOR COOPERATIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, by the Governing Boday of the Township of Maple Shade, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey to authorize an Agreement with Burlington County for cooperative participation in the Community Development Act of 1974.

SECTION I. Certain federal funds are available to Burlington County under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1987. Public Law 93-383, as amended; and

SECTION II. It is necessary to establish a legal basis for the County and its people to benefit from this Program; and

SECTION III. An Agreement has been proposed under which the Township of Maple Shade and the County of Burlington in cooperation with the other municipalities will establish an Interlocal Services Program pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., and

SECTION IV. It is in the best interest of the Township of Maple Shade that the Agreement entitled “Agreement between the County of Burlington and certain municipalities located therein for the establishment of a cooperative means of conducting certain community development activities”, a copy of which is on file at the Municipal Clerk’s Office.

SECTION V. The Township of Maple Shade shall enter into the Agreement with the County of Burlington mentioned with all supplements and agreements thereto. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Township of Maple Shade and affix thereunto the Official Seal.

SECTION VI. All resolutions or parts of resolutions that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

SECTION VII. This Resolution shall take effect immediately after passage and publication as provided by law.
